 ❖ Grand Pre National Historical Site- *A UNESCO World Heritage Site, first established in the 1680s by the Acadians. Explore engaging displays, a Victorian garden, the Memorial Church, and monuments. Tours available.  ❖ Randall House Museum- *One of the oldest buildings in Wolfville, containing lots of local history. Explore exhibits, workshops, have afternoon tea, and stroll through historical gardens. Included is the Birthplace of Hockey gallery which displays the evolution of hockey since the 1800s. Considered a 'must see' by hockey lovers. ❖ Prescott House Museum- A celebration of the life of Charles Prescott, his contributions to the apple industry in Annapolis Valley, and his house, being one of the finest displays of Georgian architecture in the province. Explore the gardens and enjoy a guided tour. The first floor is wheelchair accessible.
